

ASM Grant Project Statuses

CIP – This is the basic status that is needed to allow the sponsor or consultant to adjust information for the funding item. If a CIP project is in any other status, the sponsor will not be able to make edits to it.

MnDOT Review – MnDOT is reviewing or will soon be reviewing this project.

Reviewed – This status is to show that MnDOT personnel have reviewed the item and made any adjustments/corrections needed by MnDOT.

Needs Programming – This is intended for federal projects only in the current fiscal year to inform the sponsor to submit programming. Once submitted, the next status should be 'Awaiting application'.

Not Yet Prioritized – This status is intended for state projects only for project in the current fiscal year, or upcoming fiscal year. It denotes that funding is not yet currently identified in the budget for this project, but may occur in the future.

Prioritized – Proceed? - This status is intended for state projects only for project in the current fiscal year, or upcoming fiscal year. It denotes that funding is currently identified in the budget for this project, but intent to proceed from the sponsor has not yet been received by MnDOT and funding identification is not quite finalized.

If Sponsor proceeds with project:

Awaiting Application – Intended for both state and federal projects. Alerts sponsor that the next step in the grant process is to submit a grant request for the CIP item.

Under Grant – Active grant.

If Sponsor does not proceed with project:

Deferred / Rejected – Sponsor has indicated that the project will not proceed as offered. The project will no longer appear on the CIP.
