

Initial Motor Carrier Contact (IMCC) Education

Certification Requirement

Minnesota Statutes, Section [221.124](#) requires new for-hire motor carriers to complete the initial motor carrier contact (IMCC) education within 90 days of receiving their for-hire operating authority. We are providing you with this education in the form of MnDOT's Minnesota Commercial Truck and Passenger Regulations book, which is included with your Certificate of For-hire Operating Authority. The book can also be found on our website at mndot.gov/cvo/mntruckbook.

Once you complete the required IMCC education, fill out the self-certification form below and send it to our office by email, fax, or mail.

Please note that if you do not complete this training **within 90 days**, our office will cancel your for-hire operating authority.
