

## Attachment to: Two Cargo, Horse, or Stock Trailer Annual Permit

This addendum must be attached to a valid Two Cargo, Horse or Stock Trailer Annual Permit.

The MnDOT Oversize/Overweight (OSOW) Permit Office's Internet Home Page is noted above.

This \$120 annual (12 month) permit allows two short trailer units to travel upon designated State Trunk Highways that are designated Long Combination Vehicle Routes, when all of the following requirements are met:

1. The permit is issued to one motor vehicle which may be a truck tractor, truck, or pickup truck rated at least three quarter ton.
2. The first towed vehicle must not exceed 28'6" long, including hitch assembly, and may be a semitrailer or trailer, which included fifth wheel type trailers.
3. The second towed vehicle must not exceed 28'6" lone, including hitch assembly, and may be a semitrailer or trailer. A short converter dolly may be used between the two towed vehicles.
4. **All trailer(s) and semitrailer(s) in the combination must be empty**, including empty of trailer parts/supplies.
5. The permitted vehicle combination may only operation in Designated Long Combination Vehicle (LCV) Routes, which include the National Truck Network Routes and the Minnesota Twin Trailer Routes.
6. The Designated LCV Routes are found on the Minnesota Truck Operators Map – 1993 and attached update list, which may be obtained by calling 651-296-6000.
