

Attachment to: U.S. Postal Service Studded Tire Seasonal Permit

This addendum must be attached to a valid U.S. Postal Service Studded Tire Seasonal Permit. The MnDOT Oversize/Overweight (OSOW) Permit Office's Internet Home Page is noted above.

1. This permit is valid for only one winter season, beginning on November 15 (or later) and ending at 12:00 Midnight on April 15th after issue date.
2. The permit holder must be a U.S. Postal Service employee and must provide proof of USPS employment at the time of application.
3. A map must be provided at the time of application showing the rural mail route(s) of the carrier. A detailed list of the continuous route would be helpful.
4. The postal route may not include more than 25% of all paved roads.
5. The permitted vehicle must only be used during the course of its USPS duties, as noted on the permit. The permit allows travel between the permit holder's residence and the mail pickup station/route.
6. This permit does not authorize any additional exceptions or privileges that are not specifically allowed under the MN law for which this permit is granted.
7. There is no State fee for this permit.
