


PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Minnesota Department of Transportation and Pope County are partnering on a project to build an overpass at the junction of Hwy 29 and Hwy 55. The overpass will eliminate an "at grade" crossing with the CP Railway System.



PROJECT COMPONENTS:

- **Realignment of Highway 55** to reduce the length of the bridge over the highway. Access to Highway 29 will be removed and moved to 160th Street.
- New bridge on Hwy 29 over the existing railroad and realigned Highway 55.
- Two new roundabouts, one on Highway 29 and one on Highway 55 at the intersections with 160th Street.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

Phase 1

2021



- Realignment of Highway 55 near Highway 29
- Construction of a roundabout on Highway 55 at 160th Street
- Reconstruction of 160th Street, which connects Highway 55 and Highway 29
- Highway 55 construction and detour begins:
 July 19, 2021



Phase 2

2022

- Construction of the Highway 29 overpass bridge
- Construction of a roundabout on Highway 29 at 160th Street
- Switch traffic to the new Highway 55 alignment
- Highway 29 overpass bridge construction and detour begins:
 April 11, 2022
