



Highway 52 Safety, Access, and Interchange Location Study

June 28, 2012 Open House

Over the past several months, the Minnesota Department of Transportation, Goodhue County and Leon, Stanton, and Cannon Falls Township officials have partnered to study options for addressing safety and access concerns along Highway 52 between Hader and the southern limits of Cannon Falls.

As part of this study, the location of a future interchange in the vicinity of County Road 1 or County Road 9 is being evaluated. Options for closing access to Highway 52 at Goodhue County Road 14 and the rerouting of Goodhue County Road 14 are also being considered.

The study partners are hosting an open house to present the input received at the last public meeting and to discuss study team responses and findings. We need your input on options for the future interchange, county road rerouting, local access and driveway treatments, and the preferred option for rerouting Goodhue County Road 14. The open house will take place on Thursday, June 28th, from 5 – 6:30 p.m., with a brief presentation beginning at 5:30 p.m. Project staff will be available before and after the presentation to answer questions.
