Comment: *Historic preservation is extremely important in Red Wing. Although it may cost more in maintenance, we should provide an image as close as possible to our existing bridge. Although I like the clean look I believe we should go with Alt. 3. Have we looked at just keeping the west side of the existing structure and place a new clean structure such as 6 or 7 behind with a bike lane between for both directions. Maybe best to keep the existing bridge and rehabilitate it.*
