## Non-Lead Paint Removal Abrasive Blasting Waste Management

Removing non-lead paint should produce a blasting waste that is non-hazardous. This greatly reduces cost and regulatory requirements in handling, transport and disposal of the waste. Proper management of abrasive blasting waste must meet the following requirements:

- <u>Collection Daily cleanup of blasting waste</u>
- Storage, Temporary Off-Site Storage and Container Labeling
- <u>Sampling Waste to verify that the waste is non-hazardous</u>
- Bridge Paint Abrasive Blasting Waste Tracking Form
- Transport, Disposal and Documentation
