Notification Requirements

Written notification by the contractor must be submitted to all residences, schools and day care facilities located within 200 feet of the work area where lead paint will be removed. Notification is not required for removal of non-lead paint. The notification must be submitted a minimum of ten working days prior to the anticipated work start date and include the date when the work will begin and hours of operation. This notification is required for projects that meet both of the following criteria:

- The paint that will be removed meets the <u>legal definition as containing lead</u>.
- The total area of paint being removed on the project is greater than 500 square feet.

If paint removal operations are delayed more than five days from the anticipated start stated in the notifications, the contractor shall, at least two days before the start of abrasive blasting, submit revised notifications stating the new work start date and hours of operation.

Copies of the notification letter to residents must be kept in the project file permanently. The contractor shall supply the MnDOT Project Engineer a copy of the notifications prior to starting work.
