## Public Hearing Record

A public hearing and open house for I-94 UBOL Resurfacing Maple Grove to Rogers and Brockton Interchange was held as follows:

Thursday, February 7, 2019, 6:00pm – 8:00pm

City of Maple Grove Government Center

12800 Arbor Lake Pkwy N.

Maple Grove, MN 55369

The meeting was originally scheduled for Tuesday, January 29, 2019. However, due to extreme inclement weather and advisories of no travel in the state, the meeting was rescheduled to Thursday, February 7, 2019. One member of the public did come to the January 29<sup>th</sup> meeting; however, City of Maple Grove staff told them the meeting was rescheduled and that member of the public did attend the February 7 meeting.

Eight individuals attended the public hearing/open house meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to provide an update on the project and receive comments on the EA/EAW. At the public hearing, attendees were invited to provide comments through one of two ways: written comments (on comment cards provided at the meeting) and oral statements to a certified court reporter. Copies of all written and oral testimonies are included in **Appendix B** along with responses to substantive comments.

Staff from MnDOT and their consultants were on hand at the public hearing/open house meeting to discuss the project and to answer questions. Several informational items regarding the project were made available at the meeting including the following:

- Project overview handout
- Project display board
- Recommended alternative layout
- Noise walls and noise study results
- Floodplain impacts maps
- Water resources maps
- Comment card
- Project presentation presented by Jerome Adams and Natalie Ries, MnDOT Staff

The public meeting started as an open house with subject matter stations throughout the room including an overall layout, noise maps, floodplain maps, and water resources maps. Members of the public could learn more about the project and talk to MnDOT and consultant staff. MnDOT Staff presented an overview of the project including location, environmental impacts, and the methods that

the public could comment on the EA/EAW. A court reporter was present to document the meeting and to take public comment. The public hearing was opened, and attendees had an opportunity to approach the microphone to state their comments, could talk to the court reporter individually, or could provide written comment on the comment cards provided at the meeting. One member of the public provided oral comments and one member of the public provided a written comment card. The public hearing was concluded, and attendees could talk to MnDOT staff about the project or ask additional questions not part of the official record.

Included on the following pages are the transcript from the public hearing, copies of the newspaper legal notices, and Minnesota Environmental Quality Board (EQB) Monitor publication that announced the availability of the EA/EAW and provided details of the public hearing/open house meeting. Also included are the communications used to inform the public of the change in meeting date due to weather.


