

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOWNLOADING AND SUBMITTING AN EXCEL® PRICE SCHEDULE
WHEN RESPONDING TO A SWIFT EVENT**

Responders MUST use the Excel Price Schedule included in the SWIFT Solicitation. The State reserves the right to reject any offer that is not submitted on the Price Schedule included in the SWIFT solicitation.

PRICE SCHEDULE INSTRUCTIONS:

A Price Schedule in Excel® 97-2003 WORKSHEET (.xls), Microsoft Excel® 2010 Worksheet (.xlsx), or later version is attached to the 'Line Details' of this Event. You must 'download' and save the Excel® Price Schedule to your desktop before you can enter information or pricing. On the Excel® Price Schedule, type your responses to the requested information. **Type in the yellow/shaded cells only.** Keep descriptions to less than 250 characters per cell.

Use the TAB KEY to advance to the next cell.

Do not change pre-typed cells.

On the Excel Price Sheet(s), make sure the spec numbers (e.g., A.1, A.2, A.3.) are recorded in the proper sequence when you are filling in those lines with information. **To insert additional lines, use the "Insert Row" function.**

On the Excel Price Sheet(s), the price should represent the industry standard unit of measure for that item or option. If clarification of the unit of measure is needed, contact the AMS/Buyer prior to the Event End Date.

Type the catalog price list discount amount or percentage information in the space provided. If more than one discount applies to a catalog, state the different discounts along with the sections/products that they pertain to in the shaded space provided.

Save your completed Price Schedule.

FOR FIXED PRICE METHOD – For each **"Make & Model"** create a Price Sheet Tab at the bottom of the workbook (example: Craftsman - # 4237 Skill Saw). After equipment Information and Pricing Sheets have been filled in, save your workbook. Do this by choosing the "File" menu, "Save As" and then type the appropriate information for the workbook as the file name (example: Craftsman Tools Price Schedule).

Attach your File attachment to your Event response in the Supplier Portal.

IF YOUR FILES ARE TOO LARGE, USE A ZIP FILE

ZIP FILE INSTRUCTIONS:

If the Solicitation instructions require submittals to be uploaded/attached in a "ZIP" file, do the following:

Create one Price Schedule for each make and model offered in the Excel Workbook and title each tab with the Make and Model Number (i.e., John Deere Model #1) offered.

When all of the files have been completed in the proper format, **CREATE A "ZIP" FILE** that will contain all of the data that is being offered for the Event.

"Upload" the "Zip" file.

If the offer returned with the Event includes multiple Price Schedules and Technical Data, and is not submitted in a "ZIP" file, the State reserves the right to reject the offer in its entirety.

UPLOADING/ATTACHING INSTRUCTIONS:

To "Upload/Attach" the completed Price Schedule Workbook, you must 'upload/attach' the completed Price Schedule Workbook where indicated and select the 'I HAVE ATTACHED MY PRICE SCHEDULE' box where directed in the Line Details section of the Event.

DO NOT SELECT: 'I DECLINE TO BID ON THIS LINE' ! Selecting this box may cause your response to be rejected.

Responses will only be accepted on the Price Schedule Workbook included with the Event. The completed Price Schedule Workbook should be uploaded in either a Microsoft Excel® 97-2003 Worksheet (.xls), or Microsoft Excel® 2010 Worksheet (.xlsx). The State reserves the right to reject Price Schedules submitted in any other format. Other Excel® file extensions that MAY be compatible are: .xlsm, .xlt, .xltn, and .xlw.

Once you have completed and submitted your response, you will receive a system confirmation message that your response has been 'accepted'. Lines with a Price Schedule attached to them will show as \$0.00. Print and save the confirmation for your file. If you're having trouble submitting your response or attaching your Price Schedule, call the Help Desk at 651-201-8100 – Option No. 1.

"DO NOT" SUBMIT THE EXCEL PRICE SCHEDULE AS PDF FILES. The State reserves the right to reject responses if the Excel Price Schedule are submitted as PDF files or any other format not supported by SWIFT. Prices must be submitted as outlined above.
