Polar Flex Winter Blades

These cutting edges utilize 12 inch steel segments with Carbide tips. They are installed within flexible and reusable synthetic rubber housings that allow the segments to more closely conform to the contours of the road surface during snow and ice operations. They also isolate the vehicle operator from constant surface contact chatter and vibration. MnDOT will compare these to the JOMA Blades in use for durability, ability to clear the road surface, reduction in operator fatigue and amount of road salt used.
