

Bike to School Day Poster Contest Guidelines



Grade Levels

Kindergarten-8th grade



Materials

- 8.5" x 11" papers
- Markers, crayons, paint, pencils, or another media

How it Works

Districts, schools, teachers, parents and youth promote the Bike to School Day poster contest for kids in their respective local community and schools. Students can design a poster that shows how bicycling to school makes them feel and submit to the Bike to School Day Poster Contest Committee by **Wednesday April 26, 2017**.

Winners will be decided upon and notified prior to Bike to School Day, May 10, 2017. You are encouraged to use the complementary sample lesson plans before facilitating poster contest participation in your classroom.

Rules for Poster Design

- Students must create a poster that represents how bicycling to school makes them feel.
- Posters must be created only by an individual child. (limit one poster submission per student)
- There are two grade categories for judging: grades K-4 and grades 5 – 8.
- Use an 8 1/2" x 11" sheet of paper for poster design
- Students can use pencil, marker, crayon, paint or another media. (keep in mind that electronic submission is easiest, so macaroni art may be harder to submit)
- Complete school name, child name, and parent contact information (address, email and telephone number) in space provided at the bottom of this form.
- Entry forms must be submitted by the end of the day, April 26, 2017 via e-mail to saferoutes.dot@state.mn.us or via mail to:
