

State Aid Project Tracking On-Line Map Guidance




The State Aid Project Tracking map includes current year projects, future (+4 years) and past (-4 years) on Minnesota's local State Aid network of roads. Clicking a project line will display a pop-up dialog box with additional project information. Additionally, tied and suspended project layers are included.

Projects on the map are dependent on records within the centralized State Aid Project Tracking system. In order to be included on the map project records require key geographic and schedule data. Geographic and schedule data gaps can occur and occasionally projects can be misrepresented. Occasionally, known State Aid projects do not appear as plotted features on the map. As well as the for-mentioned geographic and schedule data omissions, the following can also contribute to missing projects:

- The project was not let by a city or county so lacks a geographic location code
- The project occurs on an unspecified road type
- The project occurs on a new road that currently lacks a geographic location record
- The project occurs on multiple roadway alignments, county or city wide
- The project occurs on an off-road location, ex: trails or buildings
