



*Safety is a core value!* The Minnesota Department of Transportation works hard to keep employees and the public safe during construction. Can you spot five different unsafe practices in this construction site?




Safety is essential for all construction projects. Common safety checks include:

- · All workerswearing a hard hat or other protective gear
- · All pedestrians obeying the posted safety signs and barricades
- · All people paying attention and keeping a distraction-free construction zone
- Removing any standing water to avoid slips and accidents
- · Avoiding standing in the path of any heavy equipment
- · Boards or loose materials that could be tripped on
- · Using safe bridges and guardrails


